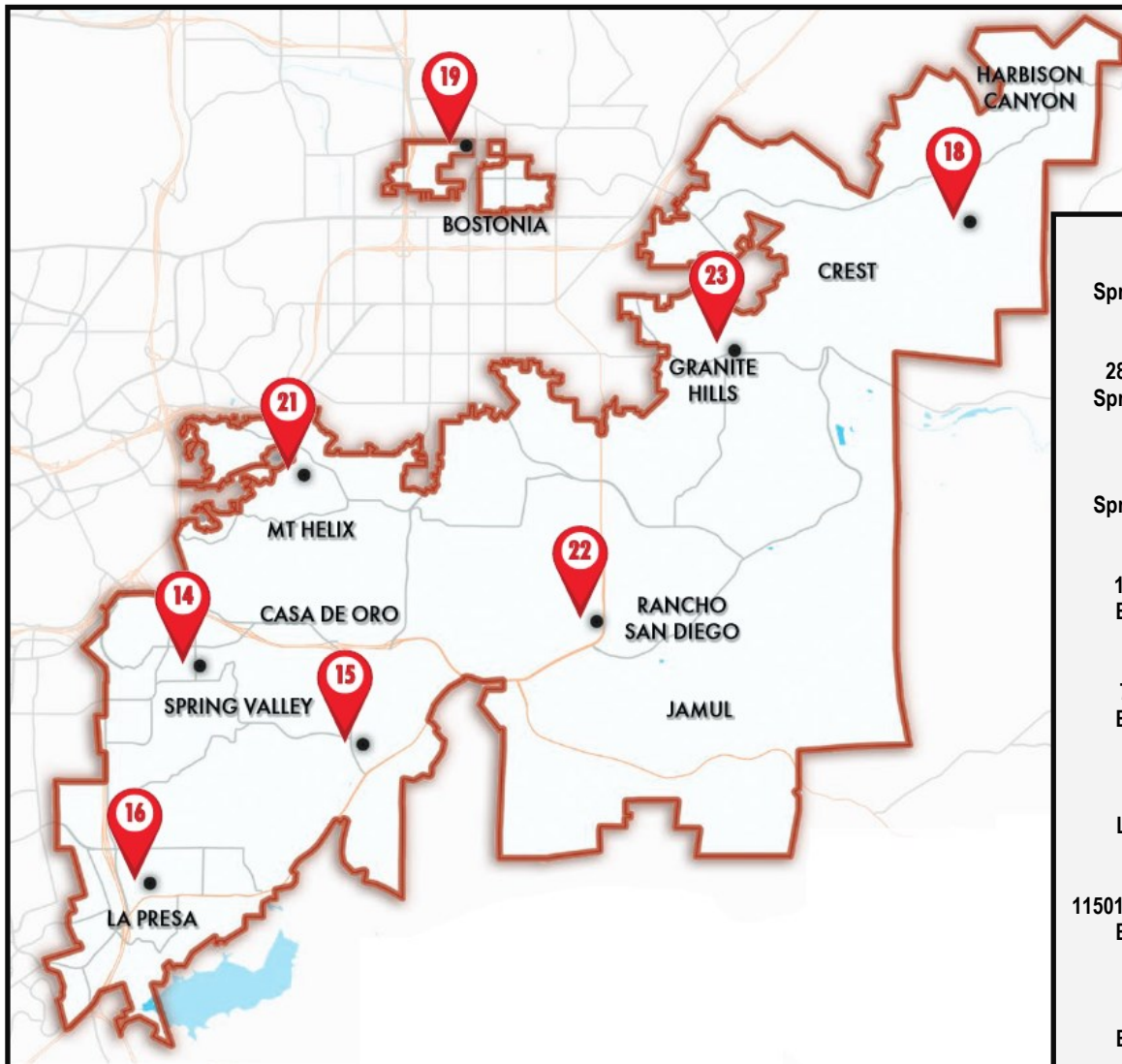

ABOUT SAN MIGUEL

San Miguel Consolidated Fire Protection District is one of the largest Fire Districts in San Diego County, operating on a budget of approximately \$25,000,000. The District serves about 140,000 residents over 50+ square miles in the communities of Bostonia, Casa de Oro, Crest, Grossmont/Mt. Helix, La Presa, Rancho San Diego, Spring Valley and the unincorporated areas of El Cajon and La Mesa.

San Miguel's 80 full-time employees provide suppression, prevention and emergency medical services. Our suppression force responds to nearly 15,000 incidents annually, including various commercial and industrial operations, single-family residences, large multi-unit apartments and condominium projects, and an extensive urban/wildland interface area.
